No permit will be issued until all of the above information is furnished, and all the above conditions met. It is the responsibility of the property owner and/ or the contractor to contact Eversource after City approval to schedule connection.
 INSPECTIONS REQUIRED: (48 hours' notice required) Underground conduit installations. When service is installed and a work order number has been obtained from PSNH. When rough-in is complete and visible (Rough). When job is complete, but before occupancy (Final). The Planning/Zoning/Building Department approval would certify that the applicant could proceed with installation of electrical fixtures in accordance with specifications submitted. Any deviation from the specifications submitted will require
an amendment to this permit or additional permits. If you have any questions, feel free to contact the Building Inspector office at 603-934-5680.
