We provide **Skilled Nursing** services to help you stay at home, instead of in the hospital, including;

- IV therapy
- Wound care, including: dressing changes, watching for infection and teaching you, or a caregiver, how to care for your wound
- Injections and injection teaching
- Medication Management: we work with you and your provider to ensure you are on the right medications and right dose as well as monitor for possible side effects
- Patient-centered education regarding chronic disease management such as diabetes, congestive heart failure (CHF) or Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)
- Physical Assessments to help assess your health status
- **Licensed Home Health Aides** to help provide personal care and carry through the plan for your care that you and your nurse developed

We also provide **Rehabilitation Therapies** to strengthen your body and increase your ability to care for yourself such as:

- Physical Therapy
- Occupational Therapy
- Speech Therapy

We have staff who can come to your home and provide **Homemaker Services** like:

- grocery shopping
- light meal prep
- errands
- laundry or light housekeeping

Medical Social Worker Services can come to help with support and resource connections related to illness or medical treatment.

- Individualized care to help you meet your end-of-life goals
- Pain management
- Provision of equipment, such as hospital beds, and medications for symptom relief at no additional cost
