The Thrift Clothes Closet has been a staple of downtown since 1999 and is now in its 24th year of operation.

It began as part of the *Twin Rivers Clergy Association* along with partners *Bread & Roses* and the *Twin Rivers Food Pantry*. A group of volunteers from area churches assisted the clergy in the operation to provide services to those in need within the Twin Rivers Area.

In 2004 the clergy group dissolved the structure and each entity reorganized as a 501c3 with its own Board of Directors.

The mission has never changed; to serve the needs of the Twin Rivers communities. Through the generosity of our donors, we are able to provide affordable clothing and essential household goods. The valuable contribution of our volunteer's time is critical to our success. Those volunteers create an atmosphere of respect, dignity and fun to anyone who shops there.

The organization has been extremely successful and we continue to provide for the needs of many as well as supporting and donating dollars and other goods to many organizations within the community. These have included: Franklin High School, Franklin Opera House, Bread & Roses Kitchen, Franklin Outing Club, Mill City Park and the Veterans Memorial Recreation Area are just a few of the organizations we offer support to.

In addition, we continue to work with area schools and our local human service offices to help those who are experiencing emergencies or urgent situations. We are proud to serve as a drop off site for *Karma Korner* within the schools.

The Thrift Clothes Closet could not do this without the generous support of our wonderful communities who donate items for sale. We accept clothing (all ages) shoes, boots, household items, glassware, pictures, paintings, linens, blankets, towels, jewelry, books, and seasonal treasures.
