Community Development Block Grant funds are available to municipalities through the NH Community Development Finance Authority. Up to \$500,000 annually is available on a competitive basis for public facility projects, up to \$500,000 for housing projects, up to \$500,000 for economic development projects, and up to \$500,000 emergency activities. Up to \$25,000 is available per planning study. All projects must directly benefit a majority of low and moderate income persons. The public hearings will hear public comment on the following:

- A proposed application to the Community Development Finance Authority for up to \$500,000 in Community Development Block Grant Public Facility funds. The CDBG funds will be used for improvements, including parking, lighting and landscaping to City owned parcels on Memorial and Canal Streets (map/lot# 117-147-00, 117-261-00, 117-154-00, 117-148-00) in downtown Franklin.
- 2. The Housing and Community Development Plan, and
- 3. The Residential Antidisplacement and Relocation Assistance Plan for this project. No relocation is anticipated.

Provisions for persons with special needs can be made by contacting City Manager's Office, via telephone or mail, at least five days prior to the public hearing.
