The Franklin City Council will hold two consecutive Public Hearings on Monday, December 7, 2020 beginning at 6:00pm. Community Development Block Grant funds are available to municipalities through the NH Community Development Finance Authority. Up to \$500,000 annually is available for economic development projects, up to \$500,000 for public facility, up to \$500,000 for housing projects, up to \$500,000 for emergency activities, and up to \$25,000 is available per planning study grant. All CDBG projects must primarily benefit low and moderate income persons. The public hearings will hear public comment on the following:

- 1. A proposed application to the Community Development Finance Authority for up to \$25,000 in Community Development Block Grant Planning Grant funds to conduct a hotel feasibility study and identify potential sites. The majority of Franklin residents are of low and moderate income.
- 2. And the Residential Antidisplacement and Relocation Assistance Plan.
