NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING & MEETING**

The City of Franklin will conduct a public hearing on the application to the US EPA for grant funds to the clean-up of the Brownfields contamination at the Ferrari Mill Site at 93-119 Memorial Street. The hearing will be held at 6:00 PM, on November 14, 2022, at the City Hall in Council Chambers, 316 Central Street, Franklin, NH. The hearing will present and discuss the application materials for the project site. The application materials, along with the Remedial Action Plan, which outlines the clean-up options and recommendations will be available on the Home page of the City Website [www.franklinnh.org] starting the morning of November 3rd. A hard copy of the materials can also be found in the City Manager's office at City Hall. Written comments on the application and the proposed clean-up plan will be accepted at the City Manager's office until 5:00 PM on Tuesday, November 15, 2022. The notice on the website provides further details.
