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## OBJECTIVES

- Greater understanding of the substance use rates among middle school aged youth in the Franklin community using the 2014 MS YRBS data.
- Better understanding of the risk and protective factors as reported by middle school aged Franklin youth in 2014.


## WHAT THE YRBS IS AND IS NOT

- It is a tool and can be used for positive changes, rather than adding negativity to the community's reputation.
- Data reflects the community perceptions and behaviors; the school is simply a place where it is administered.
- It is not a "report card" of the school.
- It does not encourage use of substances or other unhealthy behaviors.


## 2014 YRBS

- A modified YRBS was administered to all present Franklin Middle School students in Spring 2014.
- It focused on a limited number of YRBS questions from the CDC middle and high school surveys.
