The Task Force brought in Melissa Fenald who presented a *Mock Teen Bedroom* where community members were able to walk in and investigate a teen bedroom that was set up with over 80 hidden warning signs of risky teenage behavior related to substance abuse.

During this event, the Police Department did a K9 demonstration for community members to see, there was live music from Don Bartenstein, face painting done by HOPE for NH Recovery Center, the Concord Crimeline provided information on the Crimeline, and the Fire Department hosted a "touch-a-truck" for folks could explore a fire engine.

The end of the event ended with a visit from Recycled Percussion who came to Franklin to film their next episode of Chaos and Kindness!
