- Take your Scarecrow down by November 3<sup>rd</sup>. Scarecrows left up in Marceau Park or Trestle View Park past November 3<sup>rd</sup> will be disposed of.
- Winners will be announced on Halloween with prizes awarded for scariest, funniest, most beautiful, most creative and best use of natural materials.
