

Parks & Recreation Before and After School Teacher/Tutor

The City of Franklin Parks and Recreation Department seeks a qualified Teacher/Tutor for our 21st Century Before & After School Program 2018-2019 school year. The Teacher/Tutor will successfully help students ages 5-13 develop and strengthen academic, physical and social skills by providing assistance and tutoring to students in our Before/After School Program. Tutors will be responsible for providing academic tutoring and enrichment programming for designated groups of students. Tutors will work under the direction of the Program Director in conjunction with the Site Director. The Teacher/Tutor must be a team player, with the ability to assess needs, and assist students, individually or in small groups, with lesson/school assignments presenting and/or reinforcing learning concepts supporting student's academic goals and potential.

This is a part-time, school year position averaging 5-10 hours of work per week. Must be a certified teacher, paraprofessional or equivalent, with good communication skills, ability to develop effective instructional and supervisory relationships with students, maintain/record attendance, goals, and progress. Salary is \$25 per hour.
