I. UPDATE ON DISPATCH PROGRESS

Communications Supervisor Jennifer Kulacz joined the meeting to update the committee. She advised that they are still waiting on the equipment from Motorola. The other issue is the licensing at the Bristol radio tower site. Both of these issues are causing delays in the progress.

Communications Supervisor Kulacz then advised the committee that there had been three estimates on different CAD systems. They had seen demonstrations from two companies but were still researching options.

II. UPDATE ON DISPATCH PROGRESS

The minutes from the June 23, 2022 meeting were reviewed by the committee. Councilor Starkweather made a motion to approve the minutes and Councilor Blake seconded. Minutes were approved.

III. OTHER BUSINESS

Councilor Starkweather inquired regarding the condition of the fleet. Chief Goldstein advised that there are a number of cruisers that are older and requiring constant maintenance. He also reminded the committee that the cruisers are run 24/7.

Chief Goldstein advised the committee that the department is at full staff except for one open communications specialist position.
