It has been utilized as the "Hose Wagon" its entire life. This truck is in pristine condition with only 38,989 original miles and 2927 original hours. This engine has been carefully maintained by in house personnel and the City's highway mechanics.

- Bids will be accepted until 3:00 p.m., Friday, November 2, 2018,
- Sealed bids will be opened on, Monday, November 5, 2018,
- The fire engine may be viewed, by appointment only, at the Franklin Fire Station, 59 West Bow Street, Franklin, NH. Interested parties should contact Chief LaChapelle at (603) 934-2205,
- Minimum bids shall be no less than \$10,000,
- Awards will be made to the highest bidder,
- Bidders are required to provide a contact email address and phone number, as the Notice of Award will be issued promptly. If a bidder does not have an email address, a contact phone number will suffice,
- Payment in full must be received not later than ten (10) business days from the date of Notice of Award,
- Payment will be accepted only via certified check made payable to the City of Franklin,
- The fire engine must be removed from the premises within fifteen (15) business days from the date of the Notice of Award or payment may be forfeited,
- Once payment is made, the sale is final and no refund or return will be allowed.

The City of Franklin reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to accept any bid that it may deem to be in the best interest of the City.
