

# City of Franklin Household Waste Disposal Guidelines

#### **HAZARDOUS WASTE**

These items are regulated by federal & state laws and cannot be disposed of in curbside collection or at the Transfer Station. The City does have a free Hazardous Waste Collection Day on the last Saturday of July where a number of these items are accepted.

Ammunition, Anti-freeze, Asbestos, Chemicals, Explosives, Fertilizers, Fuels (gasoline, diesel, kerosene), Oil Based Paints, Paint Thinner, Pesticides, Pool Chemicals, Radioactive Materials (smoke detectors), Sealants, Stains, Unused Medications.

#### TRANSFER STATION

These items are regulated by local ordinance, can NOT be disposed of at the curbside and **MUST** be brought to the Transfer Station. Some of these items have disposal fees.

Appliances (air conditioner, dehumidifier, refrigerator, countertop appliances [blender, toaster, mixer, etc], freezer, stove/oven, microwave, washer/dryer, hot water heater, dishwasher, furnace), Batteries (wet or dry cell, alkaline, lithium, rechargeable, etc), Clothing and Shoes, Construction /Demolition Waste (lumber, vinyl siding, drywall, plywood, flooring, shingles, concrete, bricks, blocks, asphalt), Electronics (TV, VCR, CD/DVD or Blu-ray players, computer/laptop and associated peripherals, facsimile machine, copy machine), Fluorescent Light Bulbs (all types), Household Furniture, Metal Items (car and other shop parts, any single item larger than a 5 gallon container), Propane Tanks, Tires, Used Motor Oil (in one gallon containers), Used Vegetable Oil, Yard Waste (grass clippings, leaves, pine cones/needles, brush, etc), Mercury Thermostats.

Trash and recyclables are also accepted at the Transfer Station.

## **CURBSIDE RECYCLABLES**

Place loose in Recycling Container with **Green Lid** (not bagged)

<u>PAPER PRODUCTS</u> - All household & business paper of plain, pressed or corrugated types are acceptable.

Must be free of heavy soiling/contamination. (Ex: Newspapers, Magazines, Mail, Office Paper & Envelopes, Soft & Hard Cover Books, Cereal Boxes, Cardboard, Pizza Boxes, Milk & Juice Cartons, Wrapping Paper)

<u>PLASTIC</u> - All Rigid Containers marked with #1 thru #7. (Ex: Soda/Water Bottles, Milk Jugs & Detergent Bottles) No Foams, Films, Bags or Toys

<u>METAL</u> – All household metals are acceptable. Garage type items are not acceptable: see Transfer Station List. (Ex: Empty Aerosol Cans, Aluminum Cans, Aluminum Foil, Soup or Vegetable Cans, Lids from Glass Jars) <u>GLASS</u> – All glass bottles and jars (Ex: Beer, Wine & Liquor Bottles, Pickle Jars) No Plate Glass or Ceramics

### **CURBSIDE TRASH**

Bag and place in Trash Container with Grey Lid

These items must be non-hazardous, non-regulated and non recyclable.

EXAMPLES: Bubble Wrap, Plastic or Tyvek Envelopes, CDs or DVDs, Diapers, Foiled Boxes & Foiled Paper, Food (if you're not composting), Kitty Litter, Medical Syringes (properly contained), Mirrors, Photographs, Plastic Bags (bread, potato chip, sandwich, vegetable), Plastic Shopping Bags, Plastic Toys, Plastic Utensils, Plastic Wraps or Film, Porcelain Items, Ribbons & Bows, Rope, Soiled Paper Products, Styrofoam (even marked with #6) or Packing Peanuts, Waxed Boxes, Waxed Paper, & Window Glass.
